

CHAPTER 140

CONTROLLED ACCESS FACILITIES

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140.01 EXERCISE OF POLICE POWER. This chapter shall be deemed an exercise of the police power of the City under Chapter 306A, Code of Iowa, for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and for the promotion of the general welfare.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 306A.1)

140.02 DEFINITION. The term "controlled access facility" means a highway or street especially designed for through traffic, and over, from or to which owners or occupants of abutting land or other persons have no right or easement or only a controlled right or easement of access, light, air or view by reason of the fact that their property abuts upon such controlled access facility or for any other reason.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 306A.2)

140.03 POINTS OF ACCESS DEFINED. The points of access shall consist of access ways from abutting property to the adjacent traffic lane or roadway and their locations shall be expressed in terms of "stations" (each representing a distance of one hundred (100) feet, measured along the centerline of the controlled access facility from the points of reference stated in this chapter.) Such measurements shall refer to the center of the access ways which shall be eighteen (18) feet in width for residential and agricultural purposes and thirty-four (34) feet in width for commercial purposes.

140.04 ACCESS CONTROLS IMPOSED ON STATE HIGHWAY 25. Primary Road No. Iowa 25 (Fifth Street) is a controlled access facility within the area from the south corporation line (Station 584+27.0) north to Station 8+69.5.

140.05 DESIGNATED ACCESS POINTS, STATE HIGHWAY 25. Points of access are permitted on Iowa 25 between the south corporation line and the north corporation line, designated by station, side of street, curb opening or entrance width and purpose, as follows:

140.06 ACCESS CONTROLS IMPOSED ON STATE HIGHWAY 44. Primary Road No. Iowa 44 is a controlled access facility within the following areas:

1. From the west corporation line (Station 645+59) east to Iowa 25 (Station 694 + 14).
2. From Twelfth Street (Station 716+62) northeasterly to the east corporation line (approximately Station 750+20).

140.07 DESIGNATED ACCESS POINTS, HIGHWAY 44. Points of access are permitted on Iowa 44 between the west corporation line and Station 694+ 14 (Iowa 25), designated by station, side of street, curb opening or entrance width and purpose, as follows:

140.08 UNLAWFUL USE OF CONTROLLED ACCESS FACILITY. It is unlawful for any person to:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 306A.3 and 321.366)

1. Cross Dividing Line. Drive a vehicle over, upon or across any curb, central dividing section, or other separation or dividing line on such controlled access facilities.
2. Turns. Make a left turn or a semicircular or U-turn except through an opening provided for that purpose in the dividing curb section, separation or line.
3. Use of Lanes. Drive any vehicle except in the proper lane provided for that purpose and in the proper direction and to the right of the central dividing curb, separation, section or line.
4. Enter Facility. Drive any vehicle into the controlled access facility from a local service road except through an opening provided for that purpose in the dividing curb or dividing section or dividing line which separates such service road from the controlled access facility property.
5. Signs on Public Property. No signboards will be allowed on public property along said highway.
6. Signs on Private Property. No signboards will be allowed on private property when such signboards will obstruct the view of any portion of the public highway or street or railroad track.

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
