65.01 THROUGH STREETS - STOP. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop, unless a yield is permitted by this chapter, before entering an intersection with the following designated through streets.

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. Iowa Highway 44 (State Street) from west corporation limit to east corporation limit;
2. Iowa Highway 25 (Fifth Street) from south corporation limit to Iowa Highway 44 (State Street);
3. Iowa Highway 25 (Fifth Street) from Iowa Highway 44 (State Street) to north corporation limit;
4. First Street from Iowa Highway 44 (State Street) to north corporation limit;
5. Oak Street from Iowa Highway 25 (Fifth Street) to east corporation limit.

65.02 STOP REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop in accordance with the following:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. Second Street. Vehicles traveling on Second Street shall stop at Main Street;
2. Elementary Drive. Vehicles traveling south on Elementary Drive shall stop at Park Street;
3. Third Street. Vehicles traveling on Third Street shall stop at Newton Street;
4. Third Street. Vehicles traveling south on Third Street shall stop at Main Street;
5. Prairie Street. Vehicles traveling on Prairie Street shall stop at Third Street;

6. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling north on Fourth Street shall stop at Prairie Street;
7. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling on Fourth Street shall stop at Main Street;
8. Fourth Street. Vehicles traveling on Fourth Street shall stop at Newton Street;
9. Park Street. Vehicles traveling on Park Street shall stop at Fourth Street;
10. Main Street. Vehicles traveling on Main Street shall stop at Sixth Street;
11. Sixth Street. Vehicles traveling on Sixth Street shall stop at Grand Street;
12. Brown Street. Vehicles traveling on Brown Street shall stop at Seventh Street;
13. Grand Street. Vehicles traveling on Grand Street shall stop at Seventh Street;
14. Main Street. Vehicles traveling on Main Street shall stop at Seventh Street;
15. Seventh Street. Vehicles traveling on Seventh Street shall stop at Prairie Street;
16. Seventh Street. Vehicles traveling south on Seventh Street shall stop at Ashton Street;
17. Trailer Court Drive. Vehicles traveling west on Trailer Court Drive shall stop at Seventh Street;
18. Seventh Street. Vehicles traveling west on Seventh Street shall stop at School Street;
19. Eighth Street. Vehicles traveling north on Eighth Street shall stop at Prairie Street;
20. Eighth Street. Vehicles traveling on Eighth Street shall stop at Main Street;
21. Ninth Street. Vehicles traveling on Ninth Street shall stop at Main Street;
22. Tenth Street. Vehicles traveling on Tenth Street shall stop at Main Street;

23. Eleventh Street. Vehicles traveling south on Eleventh Street shall stop at Main Street;
24. Main Street. Vehicles traveling east on Main Street shall stop at Twelfth Street;
25. North Street. Vehicles traveling on North Street shall stop at Twelfth Street;
26. Thirteenth Street. Vehicles traveling north on Thirteenth Street shall stop at Bluff Street;
27. Brown Street. Vehicles traveling east on Brown Street shall stop at Twelfth Street;
28. Eleventh Street. Vehicles traveling south on Eleventh Street shall stop at Brown Street;
29. Alley east side of cemetery. Vehicles traveling north on the alley on the east side of the cemetery shall stop at Bluff Street;
30. Second Street. Vehicles traveling on Second Street shall stop at Prairie Street;
31. Prairie Street. Vehicles traveling west on Prairie Street shall stop at First Street;
32. First Street. Vehicles traveling north on First Street shall stop at Prairie Street.

65.03 FOUR-WAY STOP INTERSECTIONS. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop before entering the following designated four-way stop intersections:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. Intersection of North Twelfth Street and Bluff Street;
2. Intersection of North Seventh Street and North Street;
3. Intersection of South Seventh Street and Division Street.

65.04 YIELD REQUIRED. Every driver of a vehicle shall yield in accordance with the following:

(Code of Iowa, Sec. 321.345)

1. Grand Street. Vehicles traveling on Grand Street shall yield at Second Street;
2. North Street. Vehicles traveling on North Street shall yield at Second Street;

3. Second Street. Vehicles traveling on Second Street shall yield at Newton Street;
4. Ordway Street. Vehicles traveling on Ordway Street shall yield at Second Street;
5. Ordway Street. Vehicles traveling on Ordway Street shall yield at Third Street;
6. North Street. Vehicles traveling on North Street shall yield at Third Street;
7. Grand Street. Vehicles traveling on Grand Street shall yield at Third Street;
8. Tracy Street. Vehicles traveling east on Tracy Street shall yield at Third Street;
9. Railroad Street. Vehicles traveling east on Railroad Street shall yield at Fourth Street;
10. Railroad Street. Vehicles traveling west on Railroad Street shall yield at Third Street;
11. Grand Street. Vehicles traveling on Grand Street shall yield at Fourth Street;
12. North Street. Vehicles traveling on North Street shall yield at Fourth Street;
13. Ordway Street. Vehicles traveling on Ordway Street shall yield at Fourth Street;
14. Sixth Street. Vehicles traveling south on Sixth Street shall yield at Division Street;
15. Sixth Street. Vehicles traveling on Sixth Street shall yield at Prairie Street;
16. Sixth Street. Vehicles traveling on Sixth Street shall yield at North Street;
17. Eighth Street. Vehicles traveling south on Eighth Street shall yield at Division Street;
18. Ninth Street. Vehicles traveling on Ninth Street shall yield at Prairie Street;
19. Ninth Street. Vehicles traveling north on Ninth Street shall yield at Grand Street;

20. Eighth Street. Vehicles traveling on Eighth Street shall yield at Grand Street;
21. Eighth Street. Vehicles traveling on Eighth Street shall yield at North Street;
22. Ninth Street. Vehicles traveling south on Ninth Street shall yield at North Street;
23. Tenth Street. Vehicles traveling north on Tenth Street shall yield at Bluff Street;

65.05 SCHOOL STOPS. At the following school crossing zones every driver of a vehicle approaching said zone shall bring the vehicle to a full stop at a point ten (10) feet from the approach side of the crosswalk marked by an authorized school stop sign and thereafter proceed in a careful and prudent manner until the vehicle shall have passed through such school crossing zone.

1. Intersection of Iowa Highway 25 (Fifth Street) and Park Street.

65.06 STOP BEFORE CROSSING SIDEWALK. The driver of a vehicle emerging from a private roadway, alley, driveway, or building shall stop such vehicle immediately prior to driving onto the sidewalk area and thereafter shall proceed into the sidewalk area only when able to do so without danger to pedestrian traffic and shall yield the right-of-way to any vehicular traffic on the street into which the vehicle is entering.

65.07 STOP WHEN TRAFFIC IS OBSTRUCTED. Notwithstanding any traffic control signal indication to proceed, no driver shall enter an intersection or a marked crosswalk unless there is sufficient space on the other side of the intersection or crosswalk to accommodate the vehicle.

65.08 YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS IN CROSSWALKS. Where traffic control signals are not in place or in operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-of-way, slowing down or stopping, if need be, to yield to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within any marked crosswalk or within any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection.
